Dear Parents and Community Members,

Welcome to the 2016-17 school year. The school staff is ready and excited to serve the students of the Stanfield community. I hope this report card will provide helpful information for you about our school.

This report card includes assessment information from our second year of testing using the smarter-balanced assessment system for English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics. It also includes OAKS testing in science. Overall, our school performed behind the rest of the state (a higher percentage of students around the state scored a Level 3 or 4). In order to improve our academic achievement in math, the district has adopted and purchased math materials from i-Ready Math for grades K-8. Teachers are also intensifying their instruction

around the Common Core State Standards, working to improve small group reading and math instruction, and implementing Conscious Discipline in their classrooms to enable students to be ready to learn.

One of the most important ways you can help your students succeed in school is to make sure they are at school and on time every day. You can also help your children by reading with them for 20 minutes every day, practicing their math facts, and attending parent-teacher conferences.

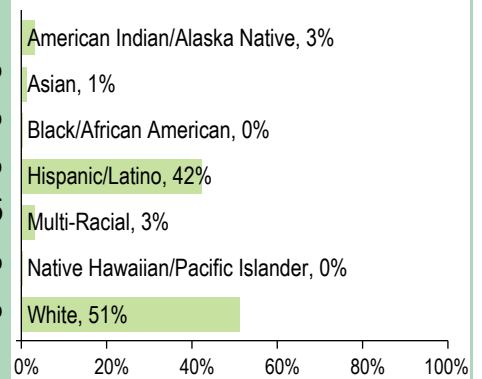

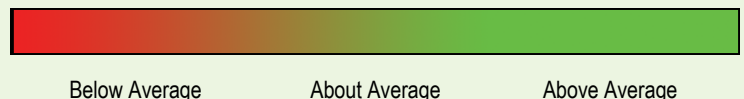
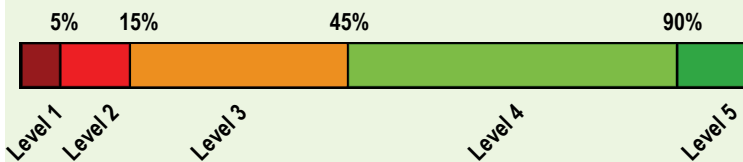
