



School Board Goals 2014/2015

Goal 1: All students in the Stanfield School District will demonstrate yearly academic growth in reading, writing, and mathematics.

- Identify and utilize effective strategies specifically aimed at improving the performance of our economically disadvantaged subgroup of students
